AOC Announces Furlough Days for 2009

Atlanta, GA--- Employees of the Administrative Office of the Courts will be furloughed on October 9, November 25, and December 31, in response to the state budget shortfall. Ms. Marla S. Moore, Director, announced that the office will be closed during those three business days and employee pay will be reduced accordingly. Ms. Moore expressed her regret that the decision to implement furloughs could not be avoided.

The Administrative Office of the Courts, an arm of the Supreme Court of Georgia, was statutorily created in 1973. The office operates under the guidance of the Judicial Council of Georgia, a policy-making body made up of judges and chaired by the Chief Justice. The AOC works alongside the state's trial court judges and other court personnel to improve the judicial system as it serves the citizens of Georgia.
