Programs

I. Community Orientated Partnerships

This program is designed to improve and assist in making the communities of Cherokee County a safer place to live and work through partnerships between the citizens and the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court. This program includes but is not limited to education, and materials, and any other items that may provide assistance to the citizens of Cherokee County to make our communities a safer place to live. This program is based on funding available through the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court Foundation. All entities of this program must meet with the unanimous approval of the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court Foundation Board of Directors.

II. Equipment and Training

This program includes but is not limited to the purchase of special equipment and training of the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court when funds are not readily available to better serve and protect the communities of Cherokee County. This program is based on funding available through the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court Foundation. All equipment and training must meet with the unanimous approval of the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court Foundation Board of Directors.

III. Fund Raising

This program is designed for the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court Foundation that includes but is not limited to community support, fund raising special events, capital campaigns, in-kind donations, government grants and grants from the public and private sectors. All funds raised through the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court Foundation will be used solely for the purpose of the foundation based on the unanimous approval from the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court Foundation Board of Directors.

IV. Emergency Aid Program

This program is designed but not limited to provide aid to participants of the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court who have been determined to be unable to meet the weekly fee requirements of the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court based on each individual's needs. This program can assist in monetary funds or be in the form of other assistance based on the needs of the participant. This program is based on funding available through the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court Foundation. All monies or items accepted from the public to be designated to a qualifying participant or specific participant in need will be met with 100% of the particular donation. All financial aid or assistance provided by the Emergency Aid Program must meet with the unanimous approval of the Cherokee County DUI/Drug Court Foundation Board of Directors.
