### **Macon AOC Office to Relocate to Atlanta as of November 1, 2009**

Atlanta, GA --- The Administrative Office of the Courts will shut down its satellite office in Macon to offset reductions to the FY2010 state budget. Announcing the decision, Marla S. Moore, Director, stated that the AOC is making every effort to comply with the Governor's request to reduce expenditures by an additional five percent. Ms. Moore stressed that the Judicial Council Budget Committee came to this decision after careful consideration: "AOC staff who provide services to the County and Municipal Probation Advisory Council and others will relocate to Atlanta; we will give up office and training space, but continue services and retain our dedicated employees."

The Administrative Office of the Courts provides services to the state's judges, trial, and appellate courts. Established in 1973, the agency oversees the annual workload assessment study for the Superior Courts, staffs judicial branch councils and committees, such as the Standing Committee on Drug Courts, and produces court system publications. Chief Justice Carol W. Hunstein is chair of the Judicial Council of Georgia/Administrative Office of the Courts.
